2021 Summer Learning Recovery MOU

The following Summer Learning Recovery opportunities will be in session beginning on June 8, 2021 through August 5, 2021 at the majority of LEUSD school sites:

- Extended School Year (IEP driven)
- Summer Literacy Camp (1st – 5th and outgoing 5th grades)
- SAI Online Credit Recovery (10th and 11th Grades)
- SAI ELA and Math Middle School (6th, 7th, 8th SAI and/ or Supported Inclusion Students)
- Spanish Literacy Summer Camp (Incoming 6th and 9th Grades)
- Online Credit Recovery (Incoming seniors and Non-grads)
- Middle School Math and ELA Summer Program (6th, 7th and 8th Grades)
- High School Brick and Mortar (Incoming Juniors)
- Virtual Elementary Summer School (CAPIT K-1) (Renaissance 2nd – 5th)

Learning recovery summer programs are a mix of In-Person Learning, (dependent on health guidelines) Online and Virtual formats.

Article 2.9 – Summer School/YRE Intersession of the Collective Bargaining Agreement shall be followed for all Summer Learning Recovery programs.

For the programs that will be offered as In-Person Learning, the following safety protocols shall continue:

- Daily Health Screening App must be completed
- Face masks or face shields and drapes, are required of all staff and students, apart from a documented medical exemption
- 3 feet social distancing shall be maintained as approved by the CDC
- All staff and students involved within the classroom shall practice and require proper use of hand hygiene and approved hand sanitizer and/ or soap and water
- PPE will continue to be available to staff for utilization in the classroom.
- Wipes and approved cleaning materials shall be made available for optional use at teachers' discretion

- Classrooms will be cleaned at the end of each day by site custodial staff
- Air filters will continue to be replaced monthly during June and July 2021
- The air intake shall be turned on two hours prior to staff reporting to their work location. The district shall continue to have air exchanges run continually throughout the summer instructional program day, Mondays through Thursdays.
- It is recommended that doors be open to assist with ventilation

It is anticipated that by June 15, 2021 the State of California may eliminate the multi-tiered system (Blueprint for a Safer Economy), however LEUSD will continue with all safety and cleaning protocols through the end of the district summer programs.
